Hello All,

First, I want to apologize for the newsletter being a week late. We held our board meeting on the 30th, but there were several things pending that I wanted to get closure on before I sent out the newsletter. As of now, we have procured new, Sunbrella cushions for the furniture in the garden area. We will not be putting cushions on the chairs at the fire pit as these chairs are comfortable enough without cushions. If you need a cushion, you are free to bring your own

to use while there. We have also just received our new chaise lounges for the pool area. The few old chaises that survived in decent condition will be placed in the garden area along with an oversize umbrella for additional lounging with some shade. All of the new items are just awaiting the pool deck, garden area and fire pit area being power-washed. Once that is complete, we will be putting everything out. We are in the process of selecting a vendor to do the job. The pergola has been power washed and refurbished. New lights in the pergola are coming soon.

American Pool is getting our pool and hot tub ready for City of Atlanta inspection. Our intention right now is to have the pool opening on or around Memorial Day. Of course, the city has to do the inspection before we can open up.

We are thrilled to see many of our neighbors have signed up and have been utilizing our website theastoriaresidents.com! If you haven't signed up yet, we encourage you to do so today! New signage has also been ordered for the pool deck and will be installed after the power washing.

We are still in the process of evaluating bids for the balcony railings. This will be a very big and expensive job so we want to make sure that we are doing a thorough due diligence before we finalize a vendor. The timeline for the project we expect will be sometime this Fall. We want to get assessments out as soon as possible to give everyone several months before we need to collect payments.

After compiling the results of the water heater survey, we are aware that there are multiple owners who have either original water heaters or who indicated that the age of their water heater is unknown. We have a plumber who has done several water heater and pipe replacements at the Astoria who is offering discounts for Astoria residents of between \$100 - \$200 dollars for a replacement. This is on an individual basis and dependent on the size/type of water heater in each unit. He is with Joule Plumbing, his name is Bob Basile and his number is 404-630-5954. He advised me that anyone who responded with "unknown" can call the manufacturer of your water heater, give them the serial number and they can tell you the age.

The last issue that I want to report on is the re-opening of the Cardio and Fitness Rooms. As of the moment, CDC guidelines are still pretty clear about the need for ventilation in an indoor exercise space. Our HVAC vendor has told me that the unit on the second floor services ONLY the second floor and that the air DOES NOT circulate in the residential areas of the building. We are exploring what, if any, protocols can be put in place to somehow ventilate or air out those areas. Now that most people are eligible for vaccination, we are also hoping that as more people get vaccinated, some of the guidelines may loosen. As of now, those amenities will remain closed.
